


A collection of 6 " knitted squares knit diagonally or corner-to-corner (C2C).

Collect them, donate them to blanket making charities, or make your own blankets.

So long as your garter stitch square (included) comes out the same size as mine, the rest should be the correct size too. If your garter square comes out larger, go down a needle size. If your garter square comes out smaller, go up a needle size. It is better for a square to be a fraction smaller than 6 " as it is much easier to stretch a knitted square than it is to stuff it into a smaller space.

## introduction

## Materials:

Any standard DK weight yarn (100g is approx. 300 m )
4.00mm needle (UK8 / US6)

Darning Needle

## Difficulty: Beginner

Sizing:
Size: 6" square

## Abbreviations:

K = Knit
$\mathrm{P}=$ Purl
St/ sts = stitches
SI1 = slip stitch as if to purl
Yo = Yarn Over
K2tog = knit two stitches together

## Pattern Construction:

All squares are cast on using the cable cast on method, and standard cast off. You may choose to use another method if preferred.

Squares are given one page each. The pattern for each square includes:
Photo of the completed square
Written Instructions
No charted instructions are included for these squares

Squares included are:
Garter stitch square (for gauge)
With eyelets
Without eyelets
Altered mitred square

## garterstitchsquare



Cast on 32 sts.
Row 1: SI1, knit to end.
Repeat row 1 another 55 times. Total of 56 rows worked. This will show as 28 garter row ridges if it's easier to count.

## Cast off.

witheyelets


Cast on 2 sts.
Row 1: Kfb, k1. (3 sts)
Row 2: Kfb, k2. (4 sts)
Increase Row: SI1, k1, yo, knit to end. (Increase 1 st). Repeat this row until you have 43 sts.
Middle Row: SI1, k2tog, yo, knit to end. Repeat row once more.
Decrease Row: SI1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, knit to end. (Decrease 1 st). Repeat this row until you have 4 sts.

Next Row: SI1, ktog, k1. (3 sts)
Next Row: SI1, k2tog. (2 sts)
Cut yarn and bind off last 2 sts.

## withouteyelets



Cast on 2 sts.
Row 1: Sl1, kfb. (3 sts)
Increase Row: SI1, kfb, knit to end. (Increase 1 st). Repeat until you have 43 sts.
Decrease Row: SI1, k2tog, knit to end. (Decrease 1 st). Repeat until you have 2 sts.
Cut yarn and bind off 2 remaining sts.
altered mitresquare


Cast on 64 sts.
Work six rows (both right and wrong side) as follows: SI1, knit to 2 st before your marker, k2tog, slip marker, knit to end.

With a 7th row as follows: SI1, knit to 3 sts before your marker, k3tog, slip marker, knit to end.

Repeat rows 1-7 until you have 2 sts remaining.
Cut yarn an bind off remaining 2 sts.
